

War Memorial Park receives the green light

THE go-ahead has been given by Castlebar Town Council for the erection of a War Memorial Park at the front of the Old Cemetery in the town.

The application, by the Mayo World War Remembrance Committee, is one of 11 projects granted permission by the authority. The list is as follows. Refurbishment of existing retail unit with additional of restaurant and four apartments at Bridge Street [*John and Jimmy Staunton*]. Change of use of existing house to office space and one apartment at 18, Kennedy Gardens [*Sylvester Jennings*].

Demolish house and construct one retail unit and two one-bedroom apartments at Linenhall Street [*Anthony J. Gaughan*]. War Memorial Park at Knockacrogghery [*Mayo World War Remembrance Committee*]. Showroom extension to garage at Aughadrinagh [*McGovern Motors*].

Change of use from existing residential house to day center at 27, Knockthomas Drive [*Alzheimer 's Society of Ireland*].

First floor extension consisting of two bedrooms at 124, Chestnut Grove [*Thomas Lavin*]. Change of use from Montessori School to shop retail unit at 5B, Humbert Mall [*Breege and Tom Henry*].

Single storey extension at rear of 5, St. Patrick's Avenue [*Brid Earls*].

New site signage at Arro Home & Garden Centre, Breaffy Road [*Goldbag Limited*].

Revisions of external elevations and modifications to internal layout of existing commercial unit at McHale Road [*Alan Green*].

A further 11 applications are awaiting decision by Castlebar Town Council. Extension and re-roofing of existing house including first floor development at Knockaphunta [*Donal Coleman, decision due on March 13*].

Alterations to existing premises and construct new lift shaft and alterations to signage at Market Square [*Castlebar Credit Union, decision due on March 14*].

Extension to existing clubhouse comprising four dressing rooms, education room and associated storage rooms at Milebush Park [*Mayo League Community Stadium Club Limited, decision due on March 15*].

Change of use and completion of existing house under construction to office use at Davitt Lane, Davitt's Terrace [*Kenpark Construction Limited, decision due on March 16*].

Two semi-detached houses together with all ancillary site development at sites 36A and 36B, Blackfort Manor [*Kenpark Construction Limited, decision due on March 16*].

Demolition of existing units, construction of three shop units and one apartment at Shamble Lane [*Fergus Kilkelly, decision due on March 20*].

Extension to existing beauty clinic at 21, Newline [*Anne Tobin, decision due on March 21*].

Renovation of existing stone building at rear for use as auxiliary office and storage area and construction of link corridor to same at Mountain View [*Walter Tuffy, decision due on March 22*].

Demolish existing lean-to sheds, construct new storage shed, retain existing roof racking system as constructed, retain existing security portacabin at Industrial Estate, Gorteendrunagh [*Helton Buckley, decision due on March 22*].

Demolish existing house and construct six dwellings at Curradrish Road, Knockthomas [*Michael McGinty, decision due on March 23*].
